

2024 ASANA World Series Field Complex Rules

USA Stadium Complex 4351 Babe Howard Blvd, Millington, TN 38053

1. Entry

- a. Anyone entering the complex must wear a 2024 ASANA World Series Wristband at all times
 - i. All rostered individuals will receive a 2024 ASANA World Series Participant Wristband from their manager.
 - ii. Non-rostered individuals can purchase a 2024 ASANA World Series Spectator wristband
 - iii. Single-day wristbands will be available for purchase during limited hours each day.

2. On-Field Restrictions

- a. **No metal spikes.** Players will be ejected from the game and can't return until they're wearing molded or turf cleats.
- b. No sunflower seeds are allowed on the fields.
- c. **No gum** is allowed on the fields.
- d. No chewing tobacco is allowed on the fields.

3. General Complex Rules

- a. Climbing on the fences or the dugouts is not allowed.
- b. Batting practice against the fences is prohibited. There are cages available for all players to use for warm-ups throughout the complex.
- c. Shoes and shirts are required
- d. No swimming in the lake
- e. All menstrual products must be properly disposed of and not flushed in toilets.
- f. Smoking is allowed within the complex, but please be considerate of those around you. Smoking is not permitted on the field, in the dugouts, or within 15 feet of a field of play.
- g. Illegal drugs are not permitted in the complex. ASANA would like to remind its participants that cannabis is illegal in the state of Tennessee and legal consequences may vary from those in their home states.
- h. No firearms or weapons permitted on the premises
- The complex will close 60 minutes after the last game ends, unless otherwise communicated by facility staff or ASANA leadership.

4. Dogs

- a. Dogs are permitted under the following conditions:
 - i. Dogs must be supervised and on a leash at all times
 - ii. Owners are responsible for their dogs and must clean up after them

5. Security

- a. Mobile security cameras will be present throughout the complex and activities will be under video surveillance
- b. Hired security guards and local law enforcement will be onsite.
- c. All participants must follow all directions and instructions given by individuals identified as security, complex facility staff, and the ASANA Board.



6. Food and Beverage

- a. **No Outside Food or Beverages** may be brought into the complex, except for water and ice. A full line of products are available from the various concessions in the facility.
- b. One, 1-gallon container of water and ice is permitted per person entering the facility.
- c. Each manager will be given one cooler tag that will allow one cooler up to 48 qt that can contain water and ice.
- d. No alcoholic beverages can be brought onto the complex grounds, including the parking lot. Consumption of alcoholic beverages in the parking lot is strictly prohibited. Anyone in violation of this rule will be asked to leave the facility.
- e. Any special dietary or health accommodations should be discussed with a member of the ASANA Board prior to the tournament.

7. Safety and Weather

- a. In the event of inclement weather, everyone in the complex will be notified by the sounding of an air horn or verbally by Tournament Operations and Umpires. We will only make this notification when we have been made aware of a serious weather event approaching the park.
- b. Immediately on notification, everyone is expected to evacuate the complex and seek shelter in a vehicle in the parking lot.
 - i. Players should not remain in the dugout as this is not considered safe shelter
 - ii. The Barn and all structures on the property are not considered safe shelters
- c. All communications on weather and schedule updates will be published electronically via official ASANA channels (e.g.: Tourney Machine app, ASANA Social Media Accounts, etc).
